#### 6.1.1 Concordia College Baccalaureate Program Onsite Survey

Jack Rydell, DNP, RN, Nurse Administrator, Jean Bokinskie, PhD, RN, Professor, Polly Kloster, PhD, RN, Associate Professor, and Susan Larson, PhD, Dean were present for this agenda item to answer questions and provide information.

Buchholz and Pfenning conducted an onsite survey visit for consideration of continued approval October 9, 2019. Surveyors examined 21 of the NDAC 54-03.2 Standards for Nursing Education Programs and found one issue of partial compliance and two issues of noncompliance. Buchholz provided a brief review of the program's history of NDBON approval, current survey findings, and regulatory environment concerns which led to the recommendation to transition the program from the in-state approval process to the out of state Recognition.

NEC Chair, Johnson provided a summary of the 2-hour deliberation that took place at the December 12, 2019 NEC meeting related to the surveyor's findings and research, program representative letters and testimony, and SAAG Askew's memo and testimony addressing NDBON jurisdiction. Johnson noted that there were two main issues for the Board to consider related to the program. 1) Utilizing the NDBON instate approval process for an out of state nursing program, and 2) Compliance concerns related to the program's use of academically unqualified faculty in the practice setting.

SAAG Askew provided a summary of his analysis of the law and rules regarding approval and recognition of out of state nursing education programs.

Program representatives were invited to share testimony and answer questions during the 1 hour 45-minute discussion and deliberation.

SAAG Askew answered Board member questions related to transitioning to out of state Recognition of the program and provided closing remarks regarding the Board's authority as defined in NDCC and NDAC.
